
A Company that services Information and

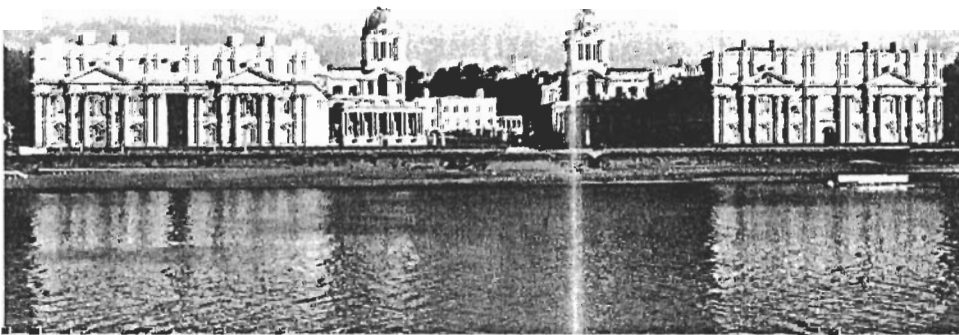
